

# IKAT

FREE JELLY ROLL PATTERN

FINISHED SIZE: 64" X 80"

**NOTE: All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise stated. Please read carefully through all instructions before you get started.**

## MATERIALS LIST

All fabrics are from 44" wide quilt-weight

**For the quilt top**

2 identical Jelly Rolls™

1/2 yard matching Moda Bella Solid for midpoints

**For the backing** 5 yards

**For the binding** 1/2 yard

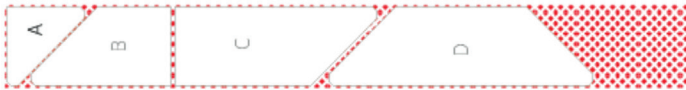
68" x 84" piece of batting (80% cotton, 20% poly)

## 1. CUTTING THE FABRICS

From the solid for the midpoints, cut 80 squares 2 7/8" x 2 7/8", split them diagonally to get 160 triangles.

Fold a Jelly Roll strip crosswise in half and place the templates as shown in the diagram below. You need to cut the pieces in this fabric saving manner to get all needed patches from one strip.

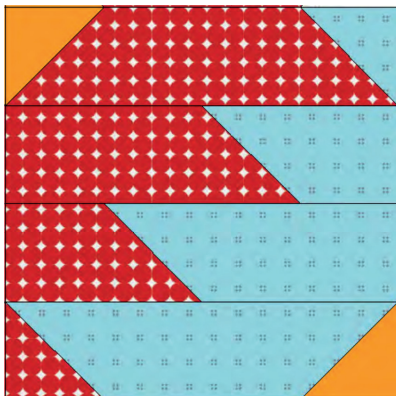
You will need 4 block-units to make one Ikat-diamond. Therefore you from one identical fabric print 4 pieces of each template. 2 pieces from A,B,C and D and 2 pieces from the mirrored templates (which you will automatically get, if your strip is folded).



## 2. ASSEMBLE THE BLOCKS

Before you start sewing you have to plan your color (fabric print) placement. Use the blank quilt layout sheet and some color pencils to design the quilt layout. Once you have determined the fabric placement, start assembling the blocks.

Lay out all pieces for one block referring to the block layout diagram. Sew together rows, then join rows to make a block-unit. The finished unit measures 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" including seam allowance.



Arrange the block units as shown below to get an Ikat-diamond. As you can see, the pieces of the red-dotted fabric appear two times as the original template shapes, two times as mirrored shapes (that's why you have to cut them from a folded strip).



## 3. ASSEMBLE THE QUILT TOP

Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram below, lay out 8 block-units in 10 rows. Sew together units in each row. Press seams in one direction, alternating direction with each row. Join rows; press seams in one direction.

Build quilt-sandwich, quilt and bind.
