





FINISHED QUILT SIZE 68" x 86"

Finished Block Size 16" x 16"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.pennyrosefabrics.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Meadow Sweets Fat Quarter Bundle (FQ-5650-21) 1½ yards (1.5 m) white main (C5650 White) 2½ yards (2.3 m) Riley white solid (C120 Riley White) Binding ¾ yard (70 cm)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Quarter Bundle

Cut 2 rectangles 2%" x 4%", 2 rectangles 2%" x 8%", 2 rectangles 2%" x 12%", and 2 rectangles 2%" x 16%" from the following fat quarters:

black main, blue main, pink floral, green diamonds, pink diamonds, yellow words

Cut 2 rectangles 2%" x 4%" and 2 rectangles 2%" x 8%" from the following fat quarters:

yellow floral, red vines, blue buds, green houndstooth, red houndstooth, black diamonds

Cut 2 rectangles 2%" x 12%" and 2 rectangles 2%" x 16%" from the following fat quarters:

black vines, yellow vines, green buds, red buds, blue words, red words

White Main

Cut 8 strips 6½" x WOF for Border 2.

Riley White Solid

Cut 2 strips $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 12 squares $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 6 strips 2½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 24 rectangles 2½" x 8½".

Cut 8 strips 2½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 24 rectangles 2½" x 12½".

Cut 9 strips 2%" x WOF. Cut the strips into 17 rectangles 2%" x 16%" for sashing and 6 squares 2%" x 2%" for posts.

Cut 7 strips 2½" x WOF for Border 1.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for piece placement as each block is a different combination of fabrics.

Around the Meadow Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Sew an assorted print 2%" x 4%" rectangle to the left and right side of a Riley white solid 4%" square to create Unit A.



Unit A

Sew an assorted print 2½" x 8½" rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit A to create the Center Unit.



Center Unit

Sew a Riley white solid 2½" x 8½" rectangle to the left and right side of the Center Unit to create Unit B.



Unit B

Sew a Riley white solid 2½" x 12½" rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit B to create Unit C.



Unit C

Sew an assorted print 2½" x 12½" rectangle to the left and right side of Unit C to create Unit D.



Unit D

Sew an assorted print 2½" x 16½" rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit D to complete the Around the Meadow Block. Repeat to create 12 Around the Meadow Blocks.



Around the Meadow Block

Blocks and Sashing

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for sashing and block placement. Sew an Around the Meadow Block to a Riley white solid 2½" x 16½" rectangle. Repeat to make a row with 3 Around the Meadow Blocks and 2 sashing rectangles. Make 4 block and sashing rows.

Sashing and Posts

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for sashing and post placement. Sew a Riley white solid 2%" x 16%" rectangle to a Riley white solid 2%" x 2%" square. Repeat to make a row with 3 sashing rectangles and 2 posts. Make 3 sashing and post rows.

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for row placement. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 70%". Top and bottom borders should be 56%".

Border 2

Side borders should be 74½". Top and bottom borders should be 68½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Meadow Sweets Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
