

Beach Plaid

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 59½" x 59½"

Finished Block Size 6" x 6"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Offshore 10-Inch Stacker (10-4920-21)
1¼ yards (1.15 m) blue main (C4920 Blue)
½ yard (50 cm) blue plaid (C4925 Blue)
¾ yard (70 cm) blue dot (C4926 Blue)
1½ yards (1.4 m) pina colada solid (C100-03 Pina Colada)
Binding ¾ yard (60 cm)
Backing 3¾ yards (3.45 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border and sashing pieces.

10-Inch Stacker

Cut 1 square 6½" x 6½" from the following assorted prints:

aqua main, blue main, tan main, aqua beach hut, blue beach hut, tan beach hut, green surfboards, tan surfboards, cream lobster, blue lobster, red lobster, aqua sailboat, blue sailboat

Blue Main

Cut 6 strips 6½" x WOF for Border 2.

Blue Plaid

Cut 4 strips 2½" x WOF for Sashing.

Blue Dot

Cut 4 strips 2½" x WOF for Sashing. Cut 5 strips 2½" x WOF for Border 1.

Pina Colada Solid

Cut 16 strips 1½" x WOF for Sashing.

Cut 1 strip 16" x WOF. Cut the strip into 2 squares 16" x 16". Cut each square twice diagonally to create 8 Setting Triangles.

Cut 1 strip 11¾" x WOF. Cut the strip into 2 squares 11¾" x 11¾". Cut each square once diagonally to create 4 Corner Triangles

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each block is a different combination of fabrics.

Sashing

Sew a pina colada 1½" strip to each side of a blue plaid 2½" strip. Repeat to create 2 short pina colada/blue plaid/pina colada strip sets. Sew 2 pina colada 1½" strips together end to end. Repeat with 2 more pina colada 1½" strips to create 2 strips approximately 1½" x 84". Sew 2 blue plaid 2½" strips together end to end to create 1 strip approximately 2½" x 84". Sew a pina colada long strip to each side of the blue plaid long strip to create a long pina colada/blue plaid/pina colada strip set.

Cut the long strip set into 1-54%" segment and 4-6%" segments. Cut one short strip set into 1-34%" segment and 1-6%" segment. Cut the second short strip set into 1-14%" segment and 4-6%" segments.

Sew a pina colada 1½" strip to each side of a blue dot 2½" strip. Repeat to create 2 short pina colada/blue dot/pina colada strip sets. Sew 2 pina colada 1½" strips together end to end. Repeat with 2 more pina colada 1½" strips to create 2 strips approximately 1½" x 84". Sew 2 blue dot 2½" strips together end to end to create 1 strip approximately 2½" x 84". Sew a pina colada long strip to each side of the blue dot long strip to create a long pina colada/blue dot/pina colada strip set.

Cut the long strip set into 1-54%" segment and 4-6%" segments. Cut one short strip set into 1-34%" segment and 1-6%" segment. Cut the second short strip set into 1-14%" segment and 4-6%" segments.

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for assorted print 6½" square, Sashing, and Setting Triangle placement. Sew rows together on the diagonal to complete the center of the quilt. Add Corner Triangles. The Corner and Setting Triangles are intentionally larger in order to square up the quilt center, leaving ½" seam allowance on all sides.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 43". Top and bottom borders should be 47".

Border 2

Side borders should be 47". Top and bottom borders should be 59".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Offshore Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
